Dear Amateur Log Rollers and Families,

We are very excited to once again be preparing for the "Olympics of the Forest" in its 58th year here at Lumberjack Bowl. The LWC will be following once again the USLRA guidelines for age brackets for junior logrollers to allow for consistency in competitions throughout the year. All logrollers are required to be a member of the USLRA for this competition. For information and application forms please go to: www.uslogrolling.com.

PLEASE MAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. U-10 and above competitions will start **promptly at 8:30 am** both Thursday (July 20) and Friday (July 21) mornings on the Log Rolling Dock
2. U-7 will start at 9:30 am on Thursday morning on the Sawing and Chopping Dock (where the amateur lessons take place). It is our hope to complete all U-7 matches on Thursday morning.
3. On the grounds **Wednesday night, July 19th** there will be a free dinner under the big top for all athletes (pro and amateur) and their families from 5:00-7:30 pm.
4. Pick up your bags and sign your waiver for competition then. *If you cannot make that time, all bags may be picked up on the morning of Thursday July 20th, prior to the start of competition over on the log rolling dock - NOT AT THE OFFICE.*
5. **Free parking** is provided for all competitors **ACROSS** the street from Lumberjack Village. This is the main parking area for LWC and is one block from the logrolling docks. **Please do not park** in the Lumberjack Village lot. This parking is needed for the Lumberjack Village employees and guests. Long term parking is not allowed. Please respect this request. Lumberjack Village is a needed partner in the running of the LWC event and they are very cooperative with us and the use of their property for our event. Show your appreciation by not parking in their lots. A full map and parking pass will be provided in your bags so you can easily park for free during your competition.
6. Entrance to the amateur competitions will be through the log rolling dock side---the LWC parking lot across the street is the nearest parking to you. The main gate is not open until 9 am each day. Match schedules will be placed on the side of the logrolling bleachers.
7. In your bags there will be a ticket for every amateur athlete to attend the Thursday night pro competition. If a family member wishes to stay and watch the pro's they will have to purchase a ticket. All family members are free to attend the amateur competitions on both Thursday and Friday mornings,
8. All logrollers must wear shoes and must be able to pole off the dock. If you are not present when your match is called, you will forfeit your match. It is double eliminations, so if you lose one match, you may still work your way back up to 3rd and 4th.
9. Be ready to roll with your official LWC amateur t-shirt on prior to 8:30 AM. There will be a large number of matches to be done in a short time period. We are hoping we can complete all amateur competitions by 12 noon on Friday at which time we will hold our awards ceremony immediately afterward on the log rolling dock.
10. Please note that there are no refunds for registrations due to the costs involved.

We are excited that you chose to be part of the sport of log rolling and we hope that this will be great fun for both you and your family!
